



Regional Information Sharing Systems® (RISS) Introduces RISSafe Mobile



RISSafe Mobile is a web-based mobile application and supports all current mobile operating system platforms.

A situation occurs that requires your immediate action to establish a surveillance operation on a subject. There is no time to access a computer to submit the operation to the RISS Officer Safety Event Deconfliction System (RISSafe™), and it is important for you to ensure that there is no other police operation underway in the area that could impact your surveillance or the other operation. What can you do?

The Answer Is RISSafe Mobile!

To access RISSafe Mobile from one of the supported devices, type m.riss.net in the browser of your supported device, follow the on-screen instructions, and enter your RISSNET user name and password. Upon first sign-in, the user must choose a RISS or federated partner system.

Note: If a Security Warning is encountered during the log-on process, the mobile device's browser software may be out of date.

After logging in to RISSNET, you will be directed to the Mobile Landing page. Once at the Mobile Landing page, click on the RISSafe icon to submit your operation. Selecting the RISSafe icon opens the RISSafe Mobile application.

In this application, you are able to enter new operations into RISSafe, access summaries of your existing operations, and obtain contact information for the RISSafe Watch Centers.

To enter a new operation, select the New Operation icon. Enter the operation information (e.g., time and date, location, operation type, crime category, criminal activity) into the Operation Details section. Once saved, the system checks for potential conflicts. If a conflict is detected, the system will notify you and provide the contact information of the officer with the conflicting operation. RISSafe Watch Center staff will also contact both officers.
