- **RISS Secure Cloud (RISSNET)**
Serves as the secure infrastructure for hundreds of intelligence and investigative systems and resources
- **RISS Criminal Intelligence Database (RISSIntel)**
Provides a real-time, online federated search of more than 60 systems containing millions of records
- **RISSLeads Investigative Website**
Generates investigative leads and facilitates multijurisdictional information sharing
- **Access to Investigative Databases**
Includes the RISS Property and Recovery Tracking System (RISSProp), the RISS Money Counter Network (MCN), the RISS Master Telephone Index (MTI), and the RISS Drug Pricing Reference Guide

Supports numerous federal agencies to meet secure information sharing mandates and facilitates information sharing to criminal justice partners

- **RISS Officer Safety Event Deconfliction System (RISSafe)**
A comprehensive and nationwide event deconfliction system that is accessible and monitored on a 24/7/365 basis and available at no cost to all law enforcement agencies
- **RISSafe Watch Centers**
Monitor events and notify officers of potential conflicts and respond to other law enforcement officer requests
- **RISSafe Mobile**
Enables officers to access RISSafe from their mobile devices
- **Subject (Target) Deconfliction Through RISSIntel**
- **Integration**
Integrated with the High Intensity Drug Trafficking Areas' (HIDTA) SAFETNet and Case Explorer event deconfliction systems
- **RISS Officer Safety and Wellness Website**
Provides secure access to vetted, reliable, and trusted information and materials on officer safety and wellness-related topics
