## What is the RISS Money Counter Network?


The RISS Money Counter Network (MCN) serves as a secure repository for case currency information, aimed at combating various money-related crimes. It empowers officers to actively “follow the money” and facilitates the connection of cases. Designed with the officer’s needs in mind, RISS MCN aids in meticulously documenting and recording the serial numbers of every dollar involved throughout the investigation’s duration. This platform enables officers to efficiently scan both incoming and outgoing currency during investigations, swiftly deconflicting serial numbers to establish connections between investigations and officers.

## How does the RISS MCN work?

Officers using properly integrated equipment can scan and automatically upload their case currency information into the RISS MCN database under their RISS Secure Cloud (RISSNET) account. RISS MCN tracks all incoming case information and updates each case as data is added to the investigation. Officers are able to access the database at any time to generate investigative reports, search for specific serial numbers, and edit case-specific information. RISS MCN automatically sends a receipt to the originating officer confirming a successful data upload. In addition, RISS MCN automatically queries all incoming serial numbers against all previously uploaded serial numbers for real-time case deconfliction. If there are cross-case hits on these serial numbers, all officers associated with the case(s) are automatically notified with the proper case and contact information to enable officers to discuss any conflicts and conspiratorial ties their cases may have.

## Why should I use RISS MCN?

RISS MCN is a fast, cost-effective, and user-friendly system to integrate into your agency’s investigations. RISS MCN enables officers to create and compile accurate reports detailing every dollar and serial number spent and seized and also offers officers real-time deconfliction of serial numbers, potentially revealing unknown case ties inside and outside your agency. It is a valuable and effective tool for officers, drastically reducing the time and effort officers take to document currency used in investigations. In addition, RISS MCN provides the option of quickly and accurately recording all serial numbers of seized money for the purposes of case deconfliction.


RISS offers full-service delivery, from the beginning of an investigation to the ultimate prosecution and conviction of criminals. An officer can simultaneously query multiple intelligence databases, retrieve information from investigative systems, obtain assistance from intelligence research staff, borrow equipment, receive training, and use analytical resources to help prosecute criminals. RISS is congressionally funded and administered by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA), through grant awards. BJA provides funding oversight and program management for the RISS Program.

## How can I start using RISS MCN?

Authorized RISS users can access the RISS MCN at <https://mcn.riss.net>. A money counter is not required to utilize the RISS MCN; however, its use will increase the efficiency of the system. ## What are RISS MCN's features?

- » Records and preserves images of serial numbers and/or images of currency for evidentiary purposes.
- » Creates comprehensive reports for each operation and case, notating details of each note used and encountered in the investigation.
- » Deconflicts serial numbers in real-time against all other active cases in the MCN.
- » Compares outgoing buy funds automatically against all future incoming seizures.
