What Is the RISS Mobile App?

The power of RISS is now in your pocket. The RISS Mobile App brings the secure information sharing and communication capabilities of the RISS Secure Cloud (RISSNET) to the smart phone. Authorized RISSNET users in the field now have the ability to search millions of available records, collaborate with other RISSNET users, and share information in the secure, intuitive RISS mobile app on their smart phone or tablet.



What Are the Security Features of the RISS Mobile App?



As with all RISS resources, the security of the RISS Mobile App is paramount. User authentication is required to use the RISS Mobile App. Multiple layers of security are used to ensure a robust and proactive level of prevention and protection of the RISS Mobile App's integrity and security.

Who Can Use the RISS Mobile App?

The RISS Mobile App is available to RISSNET authorized users only.

Why Should I Download the RISS Mobile App?

The RISS Mobile App gives users access to powerful RISS applications, including the RISS Criminal Intelligence Database (RISSIntel) and the RISS Officer Safety Event Deconfliction System (RISSafe). The app enables users to search records within RISSIntel and the RISS Collaboration Websites (including the RISSLeads Investigative Website). In addition, the advanced search feature provides users the ability to complete a more refined search of the RISSIntel database.



The RISS Mobile App is available for download from the Apple App Store.



How Can You Use RISSIntel and RISSafe in the RISS Mobile App?

RISSIntel allows for the query of criminal intelligence information. Using the RISS Mobile App, authorized RISSNET users can search records, review results, and connect with other officers who may have additional information about the subject.

RISSafe provides the ability to submit events for officer safety deconfliction. RISSafe is accessible and monitored 24/7/365 and is a reliable, secure, and critical tool for officer safety. From the RISS Mobile App, officers can enter operations, review conflicts, and respond to deconfliction events to ensure officer safety from the convenience of their mobile devices.



About RISS

RISS is a proven, trusted, and evidence-based program that supports the needs of thousands of local, state, federal, and tribal criminal justice and public safety professionals while helping advance the nation's criminal justice strategy. RISS is composed of six regional centers and the RISS Technology Support Center (RTSC). RISS focuses on three priorities: investigative case support; secure information and intelligence sharing; and officer safety, deconfliction, and law enforcement wellness. RISS offers full-service delivery, from the beginning of an investigation to the ultimate prosecution and conviction of criminals. An officer can simultaneously query multiple intelligence databases, retrieve information from investigative systems, obtain assistance from intelligence research staff, borrow equipment, receive training, and use analytical resources to help prosecute criminals. RISS is congressionally funded and administered by the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA), through grant awards. BJA provides funding oversight and program management for the RISS Program.
